

Graduate School Grade Calculation

The grading scale consists of four levels: A (fully achieves the basic goals), B (achieves the basic goals), C (achieves the basic goals at the minimum level), and D (does not achieve the basic goals. Must be retaken.). A, B, and C are passing grades, and D is a failing grade. Letter grades are indicated on report cards and transcripts for courses the student has passed. Failed courses are not included on transcripts.
