

## Student Hall

The Student Hall is not merely intended to be a place for meetings, but also a place for students to interact with other students and members of the teaching staff, deepen their friendship, enhance their education, invigorate extracurricular activities, and make university life richer.

The building is a two-story reinforced-concrete structure (total floor space: 920 m<sup>2</sup>). The first floor has an auditorium (large meeting room), a common room, offices, and a student counseling office. The second floor has a shared liaison room, small meeting rooms, a Japanese-style room, and a music and recreation room, etc.

Use of certain rooms requires the stipulated request form to be submitted to the Student Hall Office, but other rooms can be used freely. Keys can be obtained/returned at the following locations according to the time.
