

Ochanomizu University Industry–University Collaboration Programs

Collaborative Research Program

The Collaborative Research Program accepts researchers from private companies to collaborate with our faculty members on research projects. The research is conducted at Ochanomizu University using funds accepted from the companies with the researchers.

The research fund is comprised of direct research expenses and indirect costs, which account for 30% of the research expenses and are allocated to facilities and administration.

The annual admission fee is 440,000 yen per researcher.

Collaborative Research Program



Contracted Research Program

Under the Contracted Research Program, our faculty members conduct research commissioned by private companies and report the findings to the commissioning parties. The commissioners cover the costs of research. They are not required to send their researchers to the university.

The research fund is comprised of direct research expenses and indirect costs, which account for 30% of direct research expenses and are allocated to facilities and administration.

Social Collaboration Program

The Social Collaboration Program accepts funds and researchers from research institutes and private companies to carry out collaborative research and education projects with shared interests.

The fund is comprised of direct research expenses and indirect costs, which account for 30% of direct research expenses and are allocated to facilities and administration.

Researchers from research institutes and private companies must pay an annual admission fee of 440,000 yen per person.

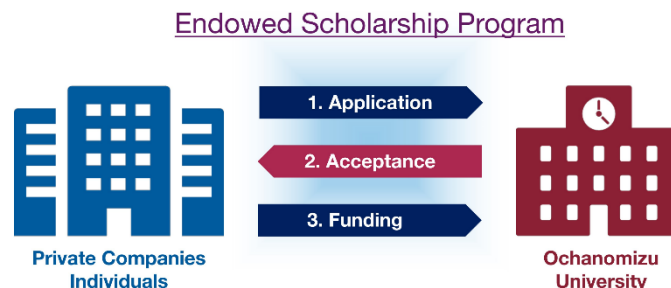
Social Collaboration Program



Endowed Scholarship Program

The Endowed Scholarship Program accepts donations from private companies and individuals. These donations are crucial to the enhancement and growth of academic research and education at the university.

In addition, endowed scholarships can be used to establish endowed courses and research departments.



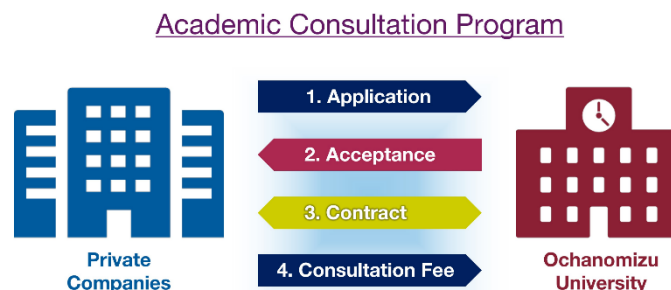
Endowed Course and Research Department

The Endowed Course and Research Department are funded by private companies. This program seeks to advance and improve education and research at the university and encourage social contribution.

Academic Consultation Program

Under the Academic Consultation Program, our faculty members provide expertise and knowledge as technical guidance and consulting services that are not regarded as research.

The consultation fee consists of direct expenses, such as compensation for the faculty members and costs associated with providing guidance, and indirect costs, which account for 10% of the direct expenses and are allocated to facilities and administration.



Visiting Researcher Program

The Visiting Researcher Program accepts private company researchers and engineers and provides them with graduate-level research guidance.

The admission fee is 278,337 yen for up to six months and 556,675 yen for a period longer than six months and up to one year.

In addition, faculty members from private schools, vocational colleges, technical colleges, and public universities may participate in other research guidance programs.
